






## A Sampling of Key Report Insights\*



Worldwide consumer spending on legal cannabis is expected to reach an estimated \$12.2 billion in 2018, a significant jump from \$9.5 billion in 2017. Canada's launch delay and California's maladroit tax & regulatory structure kept the 2018 figure less than what was originally forecast in SOLMM6.




Worldwide spending is now forecast to **grow 39.1% to \$17 billion** in 2019 – fueled by the addition of new markets across the US and abroad, and increases in the % of adults imbibing.



however, the market yielded a total of **21 million monthly** cannabis consumers overall. Inarguably the adult-use consumer segment is growing at an accelerated pace as more consumers join the market.
