California's legal cannabis market is forecast to surpass its

2017 high-water mark in 2019, generating nearly \$3.1B in spending. The latter half of 2018 and the beginning of 2019 have seen considerable improvement in the state's management of the industry's ever-growing footprint, including expanded availability of retail licenses in growth-critical municipalities.
